**FROM FR. JOE...**

Even though we weren't in a competitive class, my participation in last weekend's 32nd annual Adirondack Canoe Classic was the first time I ever entered a race, and how happy I was not only to cross the finish line after paddling 90 miles over three days from Old Forge to Saranac Lake (our time was 19:03:21), but to see some you there on the shore cheering me on! With both a priest and a minister in the boat (which sounds like the start of a joke, doesn't it?), my friend and canoe comrade, Rev. Lawrence Bartel, and I were dubbed by folks as the "Holy Rowers" and the "Paddling Pastors." It was a great experience: making new friends, seeing some incredible scenery, and discovering a strength within myself that I didn't even know might be there. Thanks to all of you for your support!

The 2014 Bishop's Fund Appeal is now underway. Last year, we raised a combined \$40,295 in our four parishes, and this year we're aiming to reach our goal of \$44,275, also increasing the number of donors from here at St. André's. Our goal is high, but I hear the same refrain playing in my head as I did during the race: *We can do it!* A gift to the Bishop's Fund is a gift to support the core works of the Church in the North Country, and therefore both a sacred duty and a way to show our gratitude to God. Such an offering from our financial resources should not only be a matter of giving some spare change, but involve a real sacrifice. I have already made my gift of \$600.00 to this year's appeal. On a priest's salary, and on top of my weekly offering (\$35 every Sunday) in the parish collection and support of other charities, that "pinches" a good bit...but the work of the Bishop's Fund is that important. We *all* benefit from it, so we *all* need to pitch in and do our part. If you've given in the past, seriously consider increasing your gift, even if only a little; if you've never given before, now is the perfect time to start. I can't encourage you strongly enough to be truly generous in making your contribution or a pledge to the Bishop's Fund.

By all accounts, our Religious Education program got off to a good start last Sunday. The number of young people involved, however, is a little low. If you missed getting your kid(s) or in the program for the first day, please get them registered as soon as possible. The next session is Sunday, September 21st. Deep thanks to Samantha and all our volunteer catechists who are doing such a great job in passing on our Catholic faith!
