A blessed feast of Pentecost to you! May the Holy Spirit enlighten your minds to know the Gospel and set your hearts on fire to spread it around!

As most of you heard last Sunday, **Fr. Justin has received a new assignment** from Bishop LaValley: As of July 1, he will become the parochial vicar of St. Mary's Cathedral and Notre Dame Parish in Ogdensburg. We'll certainly miss him around here--we were just getting to know him--but we'll be sure to give him a good send off before he goes. Bishop has assigned Fr. Scott Belina (currently assigned to the Cathedral and some work in the Chancery) to be the new parochial vicar here at St. André's. There will be other clergy changes in our neighboring parishes, as well; you can read about them all in the *North Country Catholic*. Please pray for these priests in this time of transition.

As originally scheduled, our **parish census** should be wrapping up this coming Tuesday, May 26...but it won't be. We are grateful that so many of you will visit one or more of our cemeteries this weekend. While we give special reverence for those who have served our country, visiting and praying for the dead is an invaluable work of mercy. You may wish to use the following prayer:

PRAYER AT THE GRAVESIDE

*Lord, Jesus Christ, by your own three days in the tomb, you hal-
 lowed the graves of all who believe in you and so made the grave
 a sign of hope that promises resurrection even as it claims our
 mortal bodies. Grant that our brothers and sisters may sleep
 here in peace until you awake them to your glory, for you are the
 resurrection and the life. Then they will see you face to face and
 in your light will see light and know the splendor of God, for you
 live and reign forever and ever. Amen*

**We want to remind everyone of the importance of
 following the rules and regulations at our cemeteries:**

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parents who wish to have a child baptized should contact Rev. Joseph Giroux to make arrangements for the date and for a program of preparation. Parents are highly encouraged to make arrangements at least three months before the child is born, as the Catholic Church encourages Baptism for infants as soon as possible after birth. Adults and older children (seven years or older) interested in Baptism or entering into full communion with the Catholic Church should inquire about the program of preparation (R.C.I.A.: the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults).

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

A Catholic wishing to be married in one of our churches should contact one of the priests at least six months prior to the desired date in order to begin making arrangements. A program of preparation is required. The parish should be contacted before any other plans are made—for example, the wedding reception.

SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK

For those preparing for surgery, nursing home residents, or the homebound, contact one of the parish priests to make arrangements to be anointed. For those in the hospital (especially in the event of an emergency), ask the hospital staff to contact the priest on call.
