CELEBRATING OUR HISTORY

It was 80 years ago—in 1935—that St. John Bosco Parish was established in Malone. The parish was legally incorporated on June 23 of that year, but the first parish Mass was only offered by Fr. Euclid Elie, the first pastor, on September 1 in an open field, because the parish didn't have any property yet. Just four days later, the land was purchased on which a church would be built. (An abandoned schoolhouse became the parish's first chapel while work on the church progressed through the Great Depression; St. John Bosco Church was dedicated on June 15, 1952.) St. André's Parish has strong roots in the four original parishes of Malone and Chasm Falls, and we owe a huge debt of gratitude to our ancestors who have left us such a rich legacy. We honor their many sacrifices by the way we live and share our Catholic faith today. *St. John Bosco, pray for us!*
