It means so very much to us! We may have lost the barn and about half of our livestock, but we still have our God and one another to lean on. Please continue to pray for my family (especially my father, who's been on that farm for 50 years, and my brother, who took it over just a few years ago) in the weeks and months ahead.

André's Brothers (our men's group that just got off the ground last November/December) is having a **cook out for the men of the parish next Sunday, August 6**. We'll be gathering at St. Helen's in Chasm Falls, with Vespers in the church at 4:00pm, followed by a meal and time for fraternity. We'll provide hamburgers, hot dogs (I'll probably even make some Michigan sauce...and maybe some homemade baked beans), and basic drinks, and guys can bring salads, chips, desserts, beer, etc., to share. If you can, bring your own chair ("BYOC"). This is a great opportunity for any men who are interested in joining André's Brothers, or maybe are just curious about the group—no strings attached! I'm leaving this Sunday afternoon for the shores of Lower Saranac Lake, where I'll be **spending the week as chaplain at Camp Guggenheim**. If you or any teens from your family have gone there, then you know it's a pretty special place. Please remember the staff and campers in your prayers. (I hear that St. André's will be well represented at Camp this week.) I'll be back in Malone on Friday evening...

LETTER FROM OUR BISHOP

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ:

Missionary zeal has always been a telling sign of the vitality of the Catholic Church. The annual collection for the **Missionary Projects of the Diocese of Ogdensburg (MPDO)** offers the opportunity to further our own passion in supporting the ministry of our missionaries who serve so faithfully in often forgotten places in our world.

During the weekend Masses of July 29th and 30th, the parishioners of Franklin, Clinton, Adirondack, Essex and Hamilton-Herkimer Deaneries will be given an opportunity to support our missionaries. This year, our focus turns to the Diocese of Lattakia in Syria where we continue our twinning initiative. Located on the shores of the Mediterranean Sea, Lattakia is home to the oldest Christian settlements on earth. They are experiencing a large influx of refugees which has doubled their relief efforts but depleted their resources to do so effectively. Our "*Solidarity in Faith*" endeavor will provide concrete ways for the faithful of our Diocese to learn about Lattakia while supporting their relief programs and furthering pastoral goals like catechism for children and adults, formation programs, and marriage preparation. Our parishes will offer prayers and sacrifices for the Diocese of Lattakia as we emphasize relationships over resources, practice mutuality and equality, seek to give and receive, while we learn about the strong faith of the Church in the Middle East.

The **Missionary Projects of the Diocese of Ogdensburg** Appeal will also continue to be used to provide financial support of our former mission in Mollendo, Peru, support the United States Bishops' annual Appeal for Latin America, and assist other missionary projects throughout the world as part of our evangelization efforts.

I am very grateful for your gift to this year's **MPDO** Appeal. God bless you for your generous support of the Church's missionary efforts.

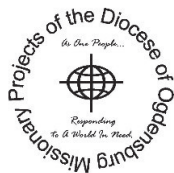

**ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP**

In Chapter Six of his Encyclical Laudato Si – Care for Creation - Pope Francis asks all believers to return to the beautiful and meaningful custom of giving thanks to God, before and after meals. That moment of blessing, however brief, reminds us of our dependence on God for life; it strengthens our feeling of gratitude for the gifts of creation. That moment of blessing acknowledges those who by their labors provide us with these goods; and it reaffirms our solidarity with those in greatest need.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parents who wish to have a child baptized should contact Rev. Joseph Giroux to make arrangements for the date and for a program of preparation. Parents are highly encouraged to make arrangements at least three months before the child is born, as the Catholic Church encourages Baptism for infants as soon as possible after birth. Adults and older children (seven years or older) interested in Baptism or entering into full communion with the Catholic Church should inquire about the program of preparation (R.C.I.A.: the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults).

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

A Catholic wishing to be married in one of our churches should contact one of the priests at least six months prior to the desired date in order to begin making arrangements. A program of preparation is required. The parish should be contacted before any other plans are made—for example, the wedding reception.

SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK

For those preparing for surgery, nursing home residents, or the homebound, contact one of the parish priests to make arrangements to be anointed. For those in the hospital (especially in the event of an emergency), ask the hospital staff to contact the priest on call.
