### *The Times, They Are A-Changin'...*

In the months we've been preparing to unite our four parishes as one, the subject of Mass times (which brings with it the use of our church buildings) has come up again and again. We currently have six Sunday Masses (including the anticipated Mass on Saturday)...but our congregation (just over 1,000 parishioners each week) could fit into just two. We have a very hard time staffing all these Masses with sufficient servers, readers, musicians, and the like. It would be ideal to have a schedule that one priest could manage if necessary (since it's getting harder to find priests to help out), as well as one that does not conflict with our religious education program for youth. With all these things in mind, Fr. Joe and the Pastoral Council have decided that we should move to having four Sunday Masses (including one anticipated Mass) beginning in January 2015. Your input is needed! At what times should Masses be scheduled? And where should they be offered? Speak with our Pastoral Council members and let them know what you think.



**SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM**

Parents who wish to have a child baptized should contact Sister Barbara to make arrangements for the date and for a program of preparation. Parents are highly encouraged to make arrangements at least three months before the child is born, as the Catholic Church encourages Baptism for infants as soon as possible after birth. Adults and older children (seven years or older) interested in Baptism or entering into full communion with the Catholic Church should inquire about the program of preparation (R.C.I.A.: the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults).

**SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY**

A Catholic wishing to be married in one of our churches should contact one of the priests at least six months prior to the desired date in order to begin making arrangements. A program of preparation is required. The parish should be contacted before any other plans are made—for example, the wedding reception.

**SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK**

For those preparing for surgery, nursing home residents, or the homebound, contact one of the parish priests to make arrangements to be anointed. For those in the hospital (especially in the event of an emergency), ask the hospital staff to contact the priest on call.
