FROM FR. JOE...

As you have hopefully heard, Pope Francis has called an extraordinary synod in Rome to address "the pastoral challenges of the family," taking place October 5-19, 2014. (The Synod of Bishops gathers Catholic leaders from around the world--both clergy and laity--to discuss important topics facing the Church.) We all know that there are many serious issues facing family life in the world today, and that the family is the essential building block not only of the Church, but of society at large. **Pope Francis has asked that this Sunday, September 28, be a universal day of prayer for the work of the synod on the family.** A card with a prayer written by Pope Francis is being distributed at Mass this Sunday. Families and individual Catholics are being encouraged, too, to pray the rosary during the synod. You'll also find some new related materials in our media racks: *Prayers for our Catholic Family*, a small booklet of traditional prayers, and *Love is Our Mission: The Family Fully Alive*, a book issued in preparation for the 8th World Meeting of Families, which will bring Pope Francis to Philadelphia in September, 2015. Let us commit ourselves to praying for families and for the Church as she tries to support and encourage them in the face of many challenges.

Speaking of our Church family...I'm so encouraged to see the first report coming in for the **2014 Bishop's Fund Appeal!** The overall appeal have reached 37% of its goal, and our parish is already at 40%. (That means we're a little better than average...but you already knew that.) Many thanks to all who have already given. Of course, it's not too late to make a contribution. SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parents who wish to have a child baptized should contact Sister Barbara to make arrangements for the date and for a program of preparation. Parents are highly encouraged to make arrangements at least three months before the child is born, as the Catholic Church encourages Baptism for infants as soon as possible after birth. Adults and older children (seven years or older) interested in Baptism or entering into full communion with the Catholic Church should inquire about the program of preparation (R.C.I.A.: the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults).

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

A Catholic wishing to be married in one of our churches should contact one of the priests at least six months prior to the desired date in order to begin making arrangements. A program of preparation is required. The parish should be contacted before any other plans are made—for example, the wedding reception.

SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK

For those preparing for surgery, nursing home residents, or the homebound, contact one of the parish priests to make arrangements to be anointed. For those in the hospital (especially in the event of an emergency), ask the hospital staff to contact the priest on call.
