If you received this bulletin in church, please be sure pray for your brothers and sisters who are heading on **pilgrimage to St. Joseph's Oratory** this Sunday. Know that we carry your intentions with us to good St. Joseph and his devoted apostle, St. André. If you received this bulletin on a bus headed to *Montréal*, please be sure to pray for the intentions of our fellow parishioners who we unable to join us as pilgrims today. And thanks for answering the call to embark on this journey to the tomb of our holy patron and the shrine he so lovingly built!

Our regular Sunday Mass schedule resumes next Sunday.

I informed you last fall that Bishop LaValley has officially "closed" the churches in Owls Head and Lake Titus. He has now also given us permission to **put the properties up for sale**. The Town of Bellmont has expressed serious interest in the former St. Joseph's Church in Owls Head, for the purpose of turning it into a community center. Given that this use is so very appropriate, keeping the structure in the use and for the benefit of the local folks who built it and worshiped there, we are not putting that property "on the market." (If no deal can be reached with the town, we will take other offers.) The former St. Mary's Church in Lake Titus is now "on the market," and anyone interested in purchasing that structure (and the .45 acres on which it sits) should speak with me or our business administrator, Andrew Duso, as soon as possible. Please be aware that, since it was a place of worship, sale is contingent on the proposed use for the property and subject to the court's and the Bishop's approval. The parish also has for sale 30.5 undeveloped acres on West Street (along the sharp bend near the river)—a property given as a gift to the parish 10 years ago or so, and from which sand and gravel have been taken for some time. Again, if anyone is interested, please let us know as soon as possible. Make the parish an offer we can't refuse!

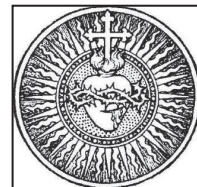
### SECOND COLLECTION NEXT WEEKEND

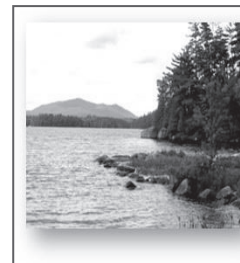

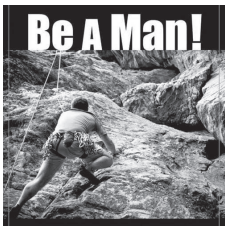

Thank you again for all you do to pray for the dead and care for the resting place of your loved ones. Please read again, the long standing policies of the cemeteries. They were crafted some years ago with the assistance of local, diocesan and national input.

**We want to remind everyone of the importance of following the rules and regulations at our cemeteries:**

**FENCES, LAWN BORDERS, ORNAMENTS, STATUES, GLASS ARTICLES, SHRUBS, OR BUSHES ARE NOT ALLOWED.**

Annual flowers are allowed to be placed adjacent to the stone. Artificial flowers are only allowed for two weeks prior and for two weeks after Memorial Day. They will be removed after that time. If you have any questions, please contact the office at 483-1300 during the hours of 9am to 4pm. The cemetery organization is not responsible for any lost or stolen items. Families of grave owners should be considerate of others. We ask that you not drive on the lawns. **SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM**

Parents who wish to have a child baptized should contact Rev. Joseph Giroux to make arrangements for the date and for a program of preparation. Parents are highly encouraged to make arrangements at least three months before the child is born, as the Catholic Church encourages Baptism for infants as soon as possible after birth. Adults and older children (seven years or older) interested in Baptism or entering into full communion with the Catholic Church should inquire about the program of preparation (R.C.I.A.: the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults).

**SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY**

A Catholic wishing to be married in one of our churches should contact one of the priests at least six months prior to the desired date in order to begin making arrangements. A program of preparation is required. The parish should be contacted before any other plans are made—for example, the wedding reception.

**SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK**

For those preparing for surgery, nursing home residents, or the homebound, contact one of the parish priests to make arrangements to be anointed. For those in the hospital (especially in the event of an emergency), ask the hospital staff to contact the priest on call.
