To the parents of young children, may we suggest...

- * Relax! The Lord put the wiggle in children, so don't feel you have to suppress it in his house. All are welcome!
- * Sit toward the front where it is easier for your little ones to see and hear. They tire of looking at the backs of others' heads.
- * Quietly explain the parts and actions of the Mass to them.
- * Sing the hymns, pray and voice the responses. Children learn liturgical behavior by copying you.
- * If you have to leave Mass with your child, feel free to do so... but please come back! As Jesus said: "Let the children come to me" (Mt 19:14).

To the other members of our parish, some reminders...

- * The presence of children is a gift to the Church. They give us "a future full of hope" (Jer 9:11).
- * The way we welcome children directly affects the way they respond to God and to the Church. Let them know that they can be at home here.
- * The parents of young children are doing a great (and sometimes difficult) thing by bringing their kids to Mass. Give them a smile and a word of encouragement!

CEMETERY REGULATIONS**(St. Joseph, St. John Bosco, Notre Dame, St. Helen)**

Thank you again for all you do to pray for the dead and care for the resting place of your loved ones. Please read again, the long standing policies of the cemeteries. They were crafted some years ago with the assistance of local, diocesan and national input.

We want to remind everyone of the importance of following the rules and regulations at our cemeteries:

FENCES, LAWN BORDERS, ORNAMENTS, STATUES, GLASS ARTICLES, SHRUBS, OR BUSHES ARE NOT ALLOWED.

Annual flowers are allowed to be placed adjacent to the stone. **Artificial flowers are only allowed for two weeks prior and for two weeks after Memorial Day. They will be removed after that time.** If you have any questions, please contact the office at 483-1300 during the hours of 9am to 4pm. The cemetery organization is not responsible for any lost or stolen items. Families of grave owners should be considerate of others. We ask that you not drive on the lawns. With the cooperation of all, each cemetery will continue to be a beautiful memorial to our deceased loved ones. Thank you for your cooperation!

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parents who wish to have a child baptized should contact Rev. Joseph Giroux to make arrangements for the date and for a program of preparation. Parents are highly encouraged to make arrangements at least three months before the child is born, as the Catholic Church encourages Baptism for infants as soon as possible after birth. Adults and older children (seven years or older) interested in Baptism or entering into full communion with the Catholic Church should inquire about the program of preparation (R.C.I.A.: the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults).

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

A Catholic wishing to be married in one of our churches should contact one of the priests at least six months prior to the desired date in order to begin making arrangements. A program of preparation is required. The parish should be contacted before any other plans are made—for example, the wedding reception.

SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK

For those preparing for surgery, nursing home residents, or the homebound, contact one of the parish priests to make arrangements to be anointed. For those in the hospital (especially in the event of an emergency), ask the hospital staff to contact the priest on call.
