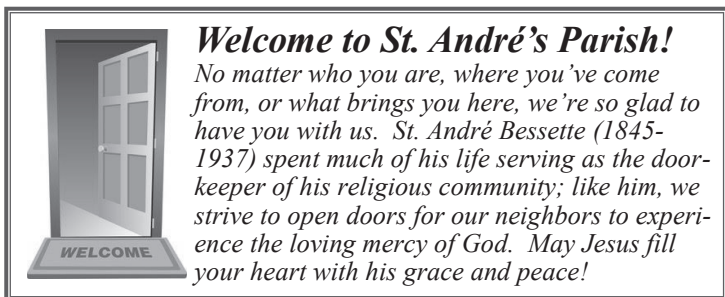

From Fr. Joe...

This past Monday, after a year and a half of careful work, **our Pastoral Council unanimously voted to approve a Pastoral Plan for St. André's.** It is now being forwarded to Bishop La-Valley and the diocesan Living Stones Planning Committee.

Given its importance, we want all of our parishioners to have the chance to see this extensive Plan—but at 13 pages long, we cannot afford to print and mail copies out to our more than 1800 registered households. **You can find the complete Plan posted on the parish website (click on the Pastoral Plan picture as it scrolls by); if you do not have Internet excess, paper copies are available in our churches.**

We know this plan will not please everybody. That would be impossible. In fact, the aim is not so much to keep people happy, as it is to be faithful to the mission the Lord has entrusted to us: *with Jesus Christ as our center, and the Holy Spirit as our guide, we are called to be a community of saints making saints—encountering the Lord in Word and Sacrament, and opening doors for our neighbors to experience the loving mercy of God.* With that as our focus, I think we have put forward, maybe not a perfect Plan, but the best we can at this time.

A few additional parishioners were present at Monday's meeting and addressed the Council about their difficulties with the Pastoral Plan. I am so very glad they were there and spoke up. Some of their words were challenging, but their presence alone was an important reminder: the decisions we must make can't be taken lightly. We are dealing with much more than statistics on paper; we're dealing with real people, their histories and their deepest feelings—and these must be handled with great care.

Yet the work of planning is about looking to the future. Of course, we build on our past (and, therefore, it ought not be forgotten), but we can't afford to get stuck in it. While our Catholic faith is unchanging, the shape and face of the Church today is not what it was even just 20 years ago when four parishes operated independently here—leave alone 50, 75, or 100+ years ago, when those parishes were established. If we don't do something soon—and the longer we wait, the more drastic the measures which must be taken—a vital Catholic community in Malone will only be a thing of the past.

Why do parishes like St. André's exist? To be instruments for God to use to bring people closer to Jesus, and so lead them to eternal life. A parish exists to get people to heaven. How many heavens are there? Just one. And (if we get there) I think all of us will be quite surprised at some of the others who have made it in...and there will likely be not a few who are surprised to see us, too. So we might as well get used to one another's company right now!

Fr. Joe continued.....

We live at a time of deep divisions in our society—times when great emphasis is put on our differences; times when, if we disagree, it's becoming increasingly acceptable to just tear the other person down. *The Church must not be like the surrounding world!* As in every age, the world today desperately needs the Church to be very, very different from the rest. Irish or French, rich or poor, village or country—we're all Catholic, and we believe in the same God, and we all hope to spend eternity in his loving embrace...which means being together forever. May our shared faith in the one Lord, Jesus Christ, unite us now more than ever.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parents who wish to have a child baptized should contact Rev. Joseph Giroux to make arrangements for the date and for a program of preparation. Parents are highly encouraged to make arrangements at least three months before the child is born, as the Catholic Church encourages Baptism for infants as soon as possible after birth. Adults and older children (seven years or older) interested in Baptism or entering into full communion with the Catholic Church should inquire about the program of preparation (R.C.I.A.: the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults).

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

A Catholic wishing to be married in one of our churches should contact one of the priests at least six months prior to the desired date in order to begin making arrangements. A program of preparation is required. The parish should be contacted before any other plans are made—for example, the wedding reception.

SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK

For those preparing for surgery, nursing home residents, or the homebound, contact one of the parish priests to make arrangements to be anointed. For those in the hospital (especially in the event of an emergency), ask the hospital staff to contact the priest on call.
