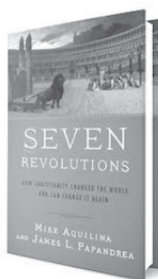
From Fr. Joe....

This is a weekend of immense joy for us here at St. André's Parish as on Saturday **Brent Charland and Nick Haas are ordained as deacons** in Ogdensburg and **Alana Beddoe enters the convent** of the Little Sisters of the Poor in Scranton, PA. We heartily congratulate them and their families, and pledge our continued support of their vocations with our prayers!

In honor of their 100th anniversary of the apparitions of Our Lady of Fatima, **Bishop LaValley will consecrate the Diocese of Ogdensburg to the Immaculate Heart of Mary** on Sunday, October 22—the 65th anniversary of the Dedication of St. Mary's Cathedral in Ogdensburg. The celebration will begin with the Rosary at 2:00pm in the Cathedral, followed by Mass at 2:30pm. In preparation, Bishop is asking all the faithful of the Diocese to join him in a **Novena beginning on October 13** (the anniversary of the last of the apparitions and the "miracle of the sun"); the prayers for the Novena can be found in this bulletin. As a note of interest in our parish: Bishop LaValley has asked that the statue of Our Lady from Notre Dame Church, which was brought back from Fatima several decades ago, be brought to the Cathedral for the occasion. ◆◆ SEVEN REVOLUTIONS ◆◆



This November, we're offering a 4-part series based on the book, *Seven Revolutions: How Christianity Changed the World and Can Change It Again* (270 pages). This will not be a "class," but a book discussion based on weekly readings—asking questions and sharing insights. The book examines the practices of the early Church—a body of Christians living in the Roman Empire—and shows how the lessons learned from them can apply to Christians living in

the United States today. It's both a great introduction to Christian history and a guide for navigating modern times as a Catholic. The series will take place on four **Tuesdays, beginning November 7, at 6:30pm** in the chapel at Notre Dame. The book costs \$20 (we only have 25 available, so sign up soon) or it can be download (\$15 on Amazon).

Memorial Gifts for New Vestments

With the ordination of our two new deacons, St. André's Parish was in need of some new vestments. We are looking for memorial gifts to cover the cost. Gifts of \$100 are sought for each of 4 deacon's dalmatics (again, in four colors), which match a set of priest's chasubles already in use at St. Helen's.
