Join your priests and fellow parishioners on Sunday, June 4, 2017, as we travel to Saint Joseph's Oratory in Montreal, Canada. This will be the three year anniversary of our inaugural parish pilgrimage in preparation for the Foundation Day of Saint André Bessette Parish.

When inspired with the idea to build a basilica in honor of Saint Joseph, Saint Brother André placed a small statue of Saint Joseph on the site of construction, and said,

"Put a statue of Saint Joseph in the center of the church, and if he wants a roof over his head, he'll take care of it."



From that time on a roof, four walls, Way of Cross, museums, cafeteria, gift shops, and countless other devotionals, have been housed at the Canadian Shrine to Saint Joseph!

When death came in 1937, over one million people filed past the body of Brother André, which at the time was laid in state at the Shrine. On June 4, 2017, we hope to add many of our own numbers to the millions who have prayed at the tomb of our patron.

There is a suggested donation of \$40.00/person to help cover the cost of the bus and dinner buffet.

go to confession, visit the gift shop, and eat lunch.

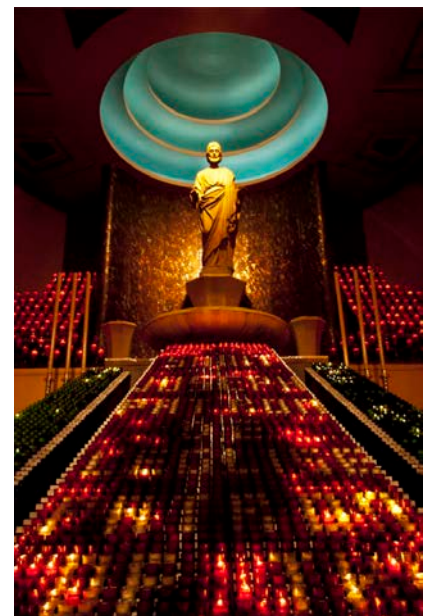
