Greetings from Fr. Scott:

When Is the Feast of the Ascension of Our Lord? In 2026, the Catholic Church will celebrate the Feast of the Ascension of Jesus on Thursday, May 14, 2026. The Church celebrated the Feast of the Ascension 2025 on Thursday, May 29. This solemnity occurs just forty days after **Easter Sunday**, and thus is the culmination of Jesus' time on earth with his disciples (Acts 1:1-10-11). In some dioceses, especially in the United States, the solemnity may be transferred to the following Sunday (May 17) to allow for broader participation among the faithful. This feast is a **holy day of obligation**, meaning that, unless legitimately excused or otherwise dispensed (**CCC 2181**), Catholics need to participate in Mass to commemorate how Jesus ascended into heaven, completing his earthly mission.

(St. Joseph, St. John Bosco, Notre Dame, St. Helen) We want to remind everyone of the importance of following the rules and regulations at our cemeteries: **FENCES, LAWN BORDERS, ORNAMENTS, STATUES, GLASS ARTICLES, SHRUBS, OR BUSHES ARE NOT ALLOWED.** Annual flowers are allowed to be placed adjacent to the stone. Artificial flowers are only allowed for two weeks prior and for two weeks after Memorial Day. They will be removed after that time. If you have any questions, please contact the office at 518-483-1300 during the hours of 10am to 3pm. The cemetery organization is not responsible for any lost or stolen items. Families of grave owners should be considerate of others. We ask that you not drive on the lawns. With the cooperation of all, each cemetery will continue to be a beautiful memorial to our deceased loved ones. Thank you for your cooperation.
